The Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 (HHFKA) requires that paid school meal prices be indexed to the federal reimbursement rates for free meals using the Paid Lunch Equity (PLE) Tool.

Below are the recommended adjustments proposed to meet the minimum price requirements:

High School	\$3.75	\$3.95
Middle School	\$3.50	\$3.75
Elementary	\$3.25	\$3.50
