## **Background Information**

In late October, a poll was distributed to MISD staff and parents via Parent Square. The poll responses provided data used to determine trends in calendar drafts. Additional hiring and professional learning needs of Midway staff were considered in the design of the calendar and distribution of professional learning dates. District-level committees met to review the calendar options and make adjustments. The following priorities were incorporated into the 2026-2027 calendar drafts:

Holiday preferences identified by respondents:

- Full week for Thanksgiving
- Two whole weeks for Winter Break
- End before Memorial Day
- Match Baylor/MCC Holiday Schedules
- Consider a Fall Break
- Consider a late Winter Break

Instructional needs identified by respondents:

- The first day of school is on Wednesday or later
- Time in August for new and returning staff to plan together for instructional purposes
- Professional Learning sessions are provided closer to the date of classroom implementation
- Embedded time in August (not June/July) to provide both district and campus professional learning to take place before the start of school
- Week of Professional Learning in May for returning teachers before everyone leaves town.
- Workdays for teachers before the start of school and throughout the year, when possible, to allow time to prepare their classrooms and lesson plans
- Ongoing professional learning opportunities are provided throughout the year to address teacher and student needs.

The following committees reviewed input which led to the development of the drafts:

November 3rd - Teaching and Learning Directors

November 3rd - Exec Team

November 4th - District Leadership Team - Exec Team, Principals, Directors, Coordinators

November 5th - Midway Advisory & Strategy Team (MAST) - Parents, Community Members,

Business Reps, Teachers

The attached presentation summarizes the calendar development process and highlights the significant differences between the calendar drafts. Staff members will be polled to determine which calendar draft is preferred before the December board meeting, when final approval will be requested.
