Consider Approval of Certified Professional Development Appraisal System (PDAS) Appraisers

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of additional 2014-2015 appraisers for the Professional Development Appraisal System (PDAS), the teacher appraisal system. The additional appraisers are new assistant principals for Denton ISD who have recently completed certification requirements.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

2014 – 2015 PDAS appraisers were previously approved by the DISD Board of Trustees on September 23, 2014.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Professional Development Appraisal System is the state approved teacher appraisal system, which was adopted by Denton ISD as the district teacher appraisal system beginning with the 2011 – 2012 school year.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Board approval of the District PDAS appraisers is required for campus administrators to initiate the appraisal system for teachers.
