Re: Restorative Practices Recommendation – Restoring Community

The School Improvement Teams at both campuses shifted their structure for the 2018-2019 school year and utilized subgroup teams. These teams utilized the following process this year:

- 1. Review data
- 2. Identify gaps/areas for improvement
- 3. Brainstorm solutions, programs, interventions, and policy/practice revisions
- 4. Research
- 5. Develop action plans

Multiple school improvement teams from both campuses identified the need for additional student interventions and associated professional development, specifically in the area of social-emotional learning. Based on this need, we are recommending the approval of the attached proposal from *Restoring Community*. The implementation goals for the proposal are as follows:

- 1. Cultivate two cohorts of 65 staff to apply proactive and responsive Restorative Practices to classroom and school-wide culture
- 2. Support school leadership to ensure the integrity of Restorative Practice implementation
- 3. Promote restorative school-wide systems, structures, and policies that influence culture change

We also believe this work will further support the action plans within Strategy 6 of the Strategic Plan. The proposal outlines how these three goals would be supported beginning during the summer of 2019 and throughout the 2019-2020 school year. The cost of the consultant is \$43,650.00 and JTHS staff participating in the summer cohorts would be paid at the contractual rate. These costs would be funded through the Title 1 grant upon approval.
