### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- In accordance with TEA guidelines, proposed charter schools must submit a “Statement of Impact” to any public school district that may be affected by new, proposed campuses or an increase in approved territory.
- These statements must be considered by Trustees in an open board meeting and must be returned to TEA by a stated deadline.
- The Trinity Basin Preparatory, a charter school whose application address originates at County-District #: 057813, 400 South Zang Blvd., Suite 700, Dallas, TX, has made application of the Texas Education Agency to increase the district’s geographic boundary by adding Aledo ISD, Arlington ISD, Birdville ISD, Cleburne ISD, Garland ISD, Italy ISD, Lancaster ISD, Mansfield ISD, Mesquite ISD, Red Oak ISD, Richardson ISD and Waxahachie ISD.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:**

- The options available on the Texas Education Agency supplied form list only the District’s response as to whether or not the District believes the addition of proposed the increased enrollment will or will not have any negative impact on Aledo ISD.

**FISCAL NOTE:** Consideration of this impact statement will have no known effect to the 2015-2016 or 2016-17 budgets.

**Administrative Recommendation:** Administration recommends opposing this application on the impact statement due to the detrimental effect loss of enrollment would have on AISD.
