Description: We are requesting permission to purchase Destiny as an inventory tool for libraries and district instructional materials to include all technology devices.

Historical Data: The district has purchased Alexandria Companion for the purpose of keeping inventory of library books, but the district has not had a tool in recent years to take inventory of instructional materials. This resource is superior to what we currently use for library materials and using it for technology devices (chromebooks, iPads, etc.) as well as for all instructional materials will simplify the district procedures in the area of inventory, giving us a solid system for keeping account of investments in these areas.

Recommendation: We recommend the purchase of Follett Destiny using ESSER funding for the purpose of upgrading our current system for the inventory and checkout of library materials, technology materials as well as for instructional materials.
