Maintenance staff has been busy replacing broken windows in the buildings to keep the rooms warm with the falling temperatures. KWB/VC:

Load/haul paving stones from the playground area between schools. Dig up/transplant trees from the playground area between schools. Remove partitions/stalls from boys/girls restroom near the KWB gym.
