Collaboration, planning and awareness took place at the end of April and the teachers began rolling out the new learning approach on May 4th. The students had 3 weeks to work on their Apple Keynote presentation, showcasing the knowledge they have gained during the 3 weeks of research and information gathering. The Coronavirus/COVID-19 Project encompassed all subject areas, Math, Science, English/Language Arts, Social Studies and Elective classes with the focus on education of the topic to diminish fear and to increase awareness for the BMS students. Once the projects were uploaded to the grade level files, the teachers were able to view each student's project and teachers were amazed at the outstanding abilities of the BMS students. On Thursday, May 28th, staff was available to collect iPads and distribute awards and Incentives. As of June 1st, students have returned 202 iPads and staff is available and working to collect the remaining 55 iPads. The remaining students received an incentive of their choice. BMS used data from 1st Quarter to March 12th to determine the awards and incentives for the year. It was a hot, sunny day and it was wonderful to see our students one last time before the summer break.

Browning Middle School will look wonderful for the 2020-2021 school year.
