Prevention

- If you are ill, stay home.
- As prior to COVID, the school policy remains that individuals must be vomit, diarrhea, and fever free (under 100.4° F without the use of fever-reducing medication) and symptoms must have improved for 24 hours prior to returning to school.
- Schools are required to use the MN Department of Health Respiratory Illness and Gastrointestinal Illness Outbreak
 Reporting form to report respiratory illness outbreaks including COVID-19 when 10% of a building's student enrollment
 is absent with respiratory illness on a given day.
- Individuals experiencing COVID-19 symptoms are encouraged to follow the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u> guidance.
