DECOMMENDATION.
RECOMMENDATION: The Office of the Governor for the State of Texas operates the Public Safety Office (PSO), which provides state and federal pass-through funding. Multiple grants have been submitted to the PSO in support of the District's safety efforts. There is a general requirement of these grants to provide a resolution from the governing body that contains the following: 1. Authorization by your governing body for the submission of the application to the Public Safety Office (PSO) that clearly identifies the name of the project for which funding is requested; 2. A commitment to provide all applicable matching funds; 3. A designation of the name and/or title of an authorized official who is given the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant (Note: If a name is provided, you must update the PSO should the official change during the grant period.); and 4. A written assurance that, in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to PSO.
It is recommended that the UISD Board of Trustees approve the attached required resolutions in support of grants submitted on behalf of the District.
RATIONALE: A resolution is required for each grant application in order to be considered for funding.
