Subject: Consider and possible Board action on approval of Interlocal Agreement for the

Establishment & Operation of El Paso County JJAEP – Chapter 37 of the Texas Education

Code

Date: August 13, 2025

HISTORY: The Interlocal Agreement for the Establishment and Operation of El Paso County JJAEP, Under Chapter 37 of the Texas Education Code, is a yearly agreement among the following school districts: Ysleta ISD; Socorro ISD; Fabens ISD; San Elizario ISD; Tornillo ISD, Clint ISD; Anthony ISD; El Paso ISD, and Canutillo ISD.

RATIONALE: The Texas Government Code, Chapter 37, requires the Board to establish a Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program (JJAEP) for El Paso County based on its population.

BUDGET IMPACT: The El Paso County Juvenile Probation Department shall fund placements only for students enrolled in the participating districts. This funding applies to students expelled from school due to conduct that mandates expulsion under Tex. Edu. Code Section 37.007(a), (d), and (e).

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION: The Administrative recommendation is to approve the Interlocal Agreement for the Establishment & Operation of El Paso County JJAEP – Chapter 37 of the Texas Education Code as presented.
