B. Discussion Items

1. School Index Rating Review

Ms. Kathy Berry from the MCISD provided the Board with an overview of Michigan's School Index system, explaining its historical context, purpose, and limitations, and emphasized that the Index is a statewide accountability tool used to identify schools for support under ESSA and not a school grade or standalone judgment of quality. Ms. Berry reviewed how scores are calculated using multiple weighted components such as achievement, growth, attendance, graduation rates, and subgroup performance, and stressed the importance of examining multi-year trends and disaggregated data rather than relying on a single overall score. Ms. Berry explained how to interpret high or low scores, noting that schools with strong scores may still have areas needing improvement and that schools showing growth from lower scores require deeper analysis beneath the surface. A Board Member asked how recent district restructuring affects the current trends, and another asked when the next set of School Index data will be released.

2. Student Data Presentation

Mrs. Andrea Wylie, Curriculum Director for Monroe Public Schools shared a presentation on the district's i-Ready assessment data for reading and math, covering the past four academic years. The assessment data categorizes students into three tiers: Tier 1 (at or above grade level), Tier 2 (slightly below grade level), and Tier 3 (1+ years below grade level). Board Members commented on a request to track cohorts as well as grade-to-grade comparisons. Board Members asked questions regarding secondary math and science scores and requested more insight into building-level intervention plans and how progress is monitored, particularly at the middle and high school levels.
