

Consider approval of Central Office access control system

1. Background:

As part of the district-wide plan to outfit Southwest ISD facilities with the best possible security solutions, District staff is recommending to install an access control system for the new Central Office facility. The most cost-effective solution is to install a similar access control system as the District's instructional sites. In addition to the new Central Office facility, upgrades are needed at the original five secondary locations that received access control systems in 2021-22. The upgrades include adding additional intercoms and card readers at various locations throughout the campuses.

3Sixty Integrated was selected as the vendor that installed the secondary campus access control project in 2021-22. They were also selected as the vendor for the current elementary school access control project. District staff is recommending 3Sixty Integrated to install the access controls system for the new Central Office facility and install upgrades needed at secondary sites.

2. Process:

3Sixty Integrated has been awarded a TIPS purchasing cooperative contract for security systems products and services.

3. Fiscal Impact:

The cost for access control installation at the new Central Office facility is \$61,464.00. The secondary campus access control upgrades will cost \$303,571.00. The overall cost of these two projects is \$365,035.00. Funding for these two projects will be provided from the Safe and Facilities Enhancement (SAFE) Cycle 1 grant funds.

4. Recommendation:

That the Board approve the access control system installation at the new Central Office facility and secondary campuses at a total cost of \$365,035.00.
