- 11. Severability/Governing Law/Assignment. The arbitrators shall issue subpoenas to compel the attendance of, and the production of documents by, third party witnesses at depositions or at the hearing. Enforcement of the arbitration award may be ordered by any court of competent jurisdiction.


