MUHS FBLA Team are State Championships!

On Monday April 14th we learned that two of our nine member FBLA team had placed at the state FBLA competitions held in Tucson. Our students competed in over 24 different competitive events against 1500 other students from across the state. Some of the events were: Cyber Security, Job Interview, Public Speaking, Website Design, Economics, Entrepreneurship, Business Law, Business Procedures and many others. Our students as a group brought home five top ten finishes including one 1st place and one 2nd place! Skyler Lemieux-Luque won 1st place in Business Procedures and Virgil Van Proyen won 2nd place in Cyber Security. Both Skylar and Virgil qualify to go to Nationals in Nashville TN.

The acronym FBLA stands for Future Business Leaders of America. FBLA helps high school students develop and sharpen primarily their business, social and leadership skills. At the college level there is PBL or Phi Beta Lambda. It has been ten years since we have had an active FBLA program that has competed in nationals.

The FBLA National Leadership Conference is five day event being held Saturday, June 28 through Wednesday, July 2, 2014. Chapter advisor, Rick Finley will be attending the national event along with Skyler Lemieux-Luque and Virgil Van Proyen.

***SUMMARY OR RECOMMENDATION:** The funding for the Rick Finley, Skyler Lemieux-Luque and Virgil Van Proyen for this trip are being paid from the V'ACTE budgeted resources.
