The week of May 2nd was a great week for our CTE program in AISD!

The sixteen first year Certified Nursing Assistant students in our program all passed the certification tests and will graduation on June 2nd. The students did a fantastic job and now have a career path after graduation.

A number of these students will use the certification as assistance in application to Registered Nursing programs while others will begin their careers after graduation as CNAs.
