5. Basketball practice has started, and our teams are preparing for their first home tournament against Atqasuk January 5-7, 2023. The basketball schedule for Kali School is attached.

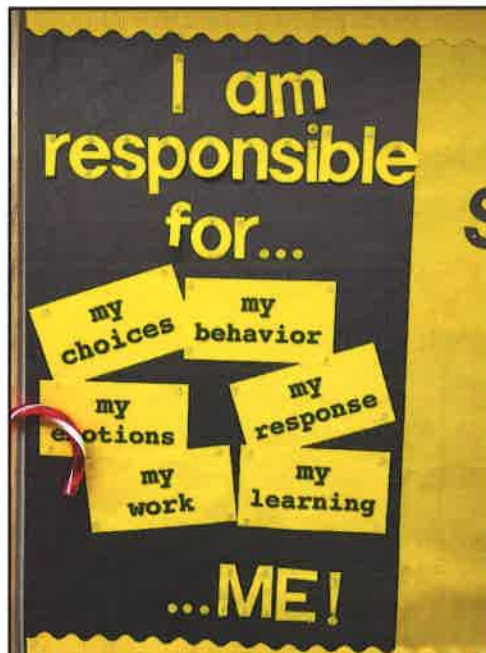
