Hugle's Happenings

April brings Showers and Scheduling

Last week we began the process with students of selecting classes for next year. On Tuesday, students met in class meetings and elective teachers talked with each group about their course offerings. 8th grade students came to campus to share in this experience and begin thinking about next year. Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, students met in TEAM to complete their "preferential polls". This is the time when students request the courses they would like to take next year. This week, our counselors will go through the same process with 8th graders as they make their course requests for their first year of high school. 8th graders will also forecast into the future what they will hope to take all four years (nonbinding, of course).

Please discuss course options with your student. Each student has a copy of the course catalog listing all of the potential course offerings. Here are some guidelines to keep in mind:

- ◆ Many courses offer college credit as well as high school credit
- ◆ Students need sufficient rigor to truly be learning new things and challenging themselves. Easier is not better.
- ◆ Students need one class each trimester that they look forward to
- ◆ Colleges have specific expectations of high school transcripts
- ◆ Just because a class is in the course catalog does not mean it will be offered. There must be enough students requesting the class for it be viable.

After we have collected all of the student requests, we will begin the process of planning our Master Schedule for 2010-11 and determining how many sections of each class are needed and which teachers will be assigned to teach which courses.



NEW RCC CLASS OFFERED TO SENIORS NEXT YEAR

Beginning fall term, Rogue Community College will offer exclusively for area high school seniors:

CG147 Decision Making.

This is a free, 1 transfer credit, online class designed to teach high school seniors how to apply decision making principles to their college and career plans. The information is not specific to RCC, but discusses higher education generally. CG147 Decision Making will be offered once in fall and once in winter—it will not be available spring or summer terms. Please contact Rogue Community College for more details.

Sophomores - 2012

Is there an Ice Cream Sundae Party in your Future?

The Class of 2012 needs just one or two more students to meet the state standards in Reading to qualify for a whole class Sundae Party! 73% of you have met or exceeded the standards on your OAKS test. When we have 74%, we'll have matched the highest percentage any high school in Josephine County has achieved. One maraschino cherry or two?

Great News!

Nearly all sophomores have now had their first opportunity to meet state standards on their OAKS (Oregon Assessment of Knowledge and Skills) test in Math. We are happy to share that even though those who did not yet meet the standards still have two more opportunities to take the test, 58% of our sophomores have already done so. Since Math has been the area we have struggled most in, we're excited and hoping the class can meet the 62% goal!

Note: the goal is the highest level any local high school has ever met.
