- 1. The meeting was called to order by Dr. Schlomann.
- 2. There was no public comment.
- 3. Workshop Purpose

Dr. Cumblad stated the purpose of the workshop was to: (a) review the previous year's direction from the previous 2011 fall workshop; (b) reflect on Mid-Valley and district trends, services and programs; (c) annually establish a means to plan and prepare for the upcoming school year; and, (d) plan and review Mid-Valley's emerging strategic plan.
