What's Happening At BHS:

- AIMSWEB testing is still in progress. Coaches and teachers are working hard to get all student's tested. Ruth Shea is coming on Thursday to finish up the final Oral Reading Fluency testing needed.
- We are fully staffed for all core content areas. All classes are going great and have google classroom set up for all students.
- Guidance counselors are continuing to meet with students- counseling center has added a new guidance counselor as of September 30th so we are working on the transition for <u>Tammy Hall-Reagan</u>back into BHS.
- Guidance counselors are continuing to work with Daniella, Kathy and now Gina for student counseling referrals.
- Instructional coaches are continuing to work with new teachers and previous teachers and have coaching cycles going to the staff that need the extra support.
- BHA and BHS will continue to refer students as needed to BHA. We have a waiting list for students who are interested or need to be referred to the BHA.

- Traditional Berry Project- Grant with BNAS- The high school is helping get the project implemented in the district. September 24th we had a kick off celebration and we planted around 400 berry trees around the school and had a berry and bannock feed for students who participated.
 - The teachers who are participating held a student art contest for the shirts and logo for the project. Justine Sharp won the contest and here are the shirts they created.



- MTDA- students are doing a great job. Mrs. Andreas does an amazing job supporting students with the rigorous classes.
- 23-24 Spring Honor Roll assembly was held on September 26th

- Mrs. Johnson took a group of students on September 25th- to The Center for Native Plants. It is

- Responsive Friday- September 13th- 72 students received tutoring. 55 of those students improved their class grades. 269 students were needing tutoring so we are still working on improving attendance on responsive days.

It was a great day with lots of smiles and laughter. The teachers planned and carried out cultural activities and enjoyed them with the students.
