Science ISATs:

All 7th grade students (103) took the Science ISATs this year. Overall, students did not do as well as they did in 5th grade, which could be attributed to several things. I looked back at Last year's class and the results are very similar.

*73% of those students showed growth from 5th to 7th grade compared to this year's 68%.
