
January's Family Night

WIDA-ACCESS 2.0 Assessment for English Language Learners (ELL)

The Napi Elementary School has 78 identified ELL Students and our testing window is from January 5th-March 6th, 2026. Napi Elementary has 100% completion for all 78 students in all four assessments: Listening, Reading, Speaking and Writing. A huge thanks goes out to the Napi Staff for their flexibility and diligence in ensuring all students are in school and completing their assessments to the best of their abilities.

NAEP-National Assessment of Educational Progress

The National Assessment of Education Progress (NAEP) is an assessment Napi was randomly selected to complete. It occurs every two years, and the process includes a random selection by NAEP, and the program randomly selects 50-4th grade students. There is a lot of work to be done to prepare for the assessment, and this process begins in September and extends to the month of January. The NAEP team completed this assessment on January 29, 2026, and successfully completed it with 87% of the students selected. The Site Coordinator for NAEP expressed that this is a successful percentage and commended the Napi Elementary for ensuring a smooth testing process.

Perfect Attendance for January

Each week, every student with zero tardies and zero absences receive school wide acknowledgement in front of their peers. Each student receives an incentive and their photo on Facebook, for their efforts and success. Beginning in the month of February, students with 95% Attendance will also be acknowledged for their success and efforts.


Aimsweb Update


