

GOOD MEDICINE PROGRAM Report
January 2017

- The Good Medicine Program staff members and school personal are adjusting the Student Support teams to fit each school.
- The Youth Mental Health First Aid trainings occurred on December 10-11, 2016, which offered the two \$25 gift cards to the community participants. The next schedule training will be January 24-25, 2016.
- The Good Medicine Program staff and five school counselors will instruct the Question Pursue Refer (QPR) suicide prevention trainings once a month to school staff and community members that are interested, starting in January 2017.
- We continually have four Bachelor Social Work practicum students and they are actively involved in creating and facilitating groups with supervision. We may be taking a few more students on as they are looking for practicum placement.
- The GMP staff members are continuing to work with students, families, and on creating identified groups and gathering referrals for students.
- The Good Medicine Program Director is continuing to get buy in for the Noble Referral System. The roll out date will be in February 2017.
