**RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS OF VOTES OF
FRIDLEY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 14
GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 4, 2025**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Fridley Independent School District No. 14, State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the General Election of the voters of this school district held on November 4, 2025, was in all respects duly and legally held.

2. As specified in the attached Abstract and Return of Votes Cast, a total of 1,500 voters of the district voted at said General Election on the election of three (3) school board members for three (3) four (4) year vacancies on the board caused by expiration of term on the first Monday in January following the general election. Votes cast for the office are as follows:

3. Avonna Starck, Sara Schreiner, and Nikki Auna, having received the highest number of votes, are elected to four (4) year terms beginning on the first Monday in January, 2026.

4. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the Special Election of the voters of this school district held on November 4, 2025, was in all respects duly and legally held.

5. As specified in the attached Abstract and Return of Votes Cast, a total of 1,500 voters of the district voted at said Special Election on the election of one (1) school board members for one (1) term to fill the unexpired term caused by a school board member resignation. Votes cast for the office are as follows:

6. Pajjar Yang, having received the highest number of votes, is elected to fill the unexpired term beginning immediately after receiving the certificate of election and taking the oath of office.

7. The clerk is hereby directed to certify results of the General and Special Election to the county auditors of each county in which the school district is located in whole or in part.

8. After the time for contesting the election has passed and the candidate has filed all campaign financial reports required by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 211A, the clerk is hereby directed to deliver a certificate of election to each person entitled thereto. The clerk is also hereby directed to enclose with the certificate a form of acceptance of office and oath of office.
