JANUARY 2020

Howdy all.

We had an interesting January. We had two snow days and we served 17 days which is one day less than 2019. Our numbers for 2020 lunches were 44,934 and for 2019 we served 47,525. Our daily average for 2020 is 2643 and for 2019 was 2640. You can see that the average numbers are pretty much the same.

Our numbers for breakfast for 2020 were 16,901 and for 2019 the numbers were 17,533. The daily average for 2020 was 994 and for 2019 were 974, so we are showing a small increase in breakfast numbers for 2020.

We had a reimbursement of \$145,327.65 for January of 2020 and for 2019 we had a reimbursement of \$148,788.14.

The only project that we are working on is our new Point of Sale software and computers. We have gone live with all schools as of 2/20/2020. Everything went smoothly as we moved over to the new system. We are still with Heartland which is the company that did out Nutrikids Software, but their new program is called Mosaic and it is a cloud based program. We will no longer be on the District server. We also installed new pin pads at the middle and the high schools for the students to input their ID numbers.
