

Overview



- Recommendation: Postpone
 Health (6-12) and Social Science
 (K-5) adoption to 2026-27
- Purpose: Ensure high-quality implementation, teacher capacity, and compliance
- Maintain continuity of instruction with current curriculum

Teacher Workload & Capacity



- 6-12 already undergoing Social Science adoption and recently completed Math and Science adoption processes
- Adoption processes are time-intensive and require significant teacher involvement
- Only one secondary instructional coach is available to support adoption

Compliance and Immediate Needs




- Elementary Health curriculum adoption required to meet Division 22 standards
- Currently, no district-wide elementary Health curriculum
- Limited elementary instructional coaching support

Community Engagement and Regional Collaboration



- Collaborate with Columbia
 Gorge ESD for potential regional
 approach
- Promote coherence across districts
- Time to engage larger community, including Native community
- Ensure a coherent and culturally responsive adoption process

Impact on Current Instruction



- Secondary Health: continues using current curriculum
- Elementary Health: existing resources in place; Social Science integrated through Wit & Wisdom
- TLA partnering with CGESD and the CREN for unit planning, Tribal History, and place-based learning

Strategic Alignment & Future Planning



 Postponement avoids cumulative adoption demands on teachers

 Supports high-quality, thoughtful implementation

 Aligns teacher capacity, coaching support, and community engagement
