School Goal:

- 1.1 Wells Road Intermediate students will achieve levels of proficiency or higher on the state assessment by monitoring their growth and performance over time and providing high-quality effective instruction.
 - Review and discuss progress monitoring data including Interim Assessment Block (IAB),
 Formative Assessments, STAR and Running Records during weekly Coaches and Grade Level Team Meetings.
 - Focus on small group instruction including during "What I Need" (WIN) Time.
 - Progress Monitoring through the Student Intervention Team (SIT) Process.
 - Embedded professional development with Teachers College Staff Developer and instructional coaches for reading and writing instruction.

School Goal:

- 1.2 Wells Road Intermediate School will develop a culture of data in which teachers gather and analyze a variety of data sources to inform instruction for their class as a whole as well as individual students.
 - Use newly formed School Improvement Team Leadership to review whole school data and trends.
 - Utilize Grade Level/Department Meetings and Coaches PLC Meeting to discuss benchmark data and next step planning.
 - Continue Tier 1 progress monitoring through Student Intervention Team (SIT) Process.
 - Investigate and implement data collection tools.

Board Goal #2: Community Engagement

Enhance communication and build trusting relationships with all stakeholders.

School Goal:

Wells Road Intermediate School, will enhance communication that reaches all stakeholders in a timely fashion.

- Continue weekly school and classroom communication.
- Sustain monthly newsletter which contains schoolwide information and highlights.
- Increase regular communication including digital media to share celebrations and success in addition to typical announcements.
- Work collaboratively with Elementary PTO.

Board Goal #3: Safety and Social Emotional Well-being

Foster a safe and positive social emotional environment for everyone.

School Goal:

Fully implement a social and emotional well-being curriculum and behavioral expectations that provide a common experience for all learners and plans for intervention supports and crisis management for our students.

- Use Minute Meeting Data to identify at-risk students.
- Create and maintain a schedule with designated time for Morning Meeting and Social Emotional Learning (SEL) Curriculum.
- Implement consistent SEL using the Collaborative for Academic, Social, and Emotional Learning (CASEL) framework.
- Ongoing professional learning activities that focus on student social emotional well being with a focus on Equity, Learning Environment and SEL practices

Board Goal #4: Budget Development and Fiscal Management

Practice responsible budget development and management through transparency and maximize available financial resources through a balance of fiscal discipline and innovative educational investments.

School Goal:

Continue to create a long-term financial plan which aligns with the vision of the Board of Finance.

- Work with all stakeholders within Granby Public Schools to ensure an up-to-date Small-Cap Budget that reflects the current needs of the intermediate school.
- Monitor class sizes to ensure appropriate learning environments and staffing.

Board Goal #5: Embracing Diversity

Adopt and promote strong instructional, curricular and leadership practices that embrace and advance knowledge and acceptance of human diversity and that eliminate bias.

School Goals:

Ensure system-wide practices and structures are in place at Wells Road to support the implementation of Granby Public Schools Anti-Bias/Anti-Racism Plan.

- Granby Equity Team (GET) members meet with SIT (School Improvement Team)
 Leadership to discuss and embed culturally proficient practices in daily routines,
 instruction and materials.
- Continue First 50 schoolwide diverse book program.
- Build a budget to increase diverse books and materials.

Board Goal #6: Professional Learning

Develop the instructional skills and strategies of our teaching staff through ongoing, meaningful and systemic professional learning opportunities.

School Goals:

Implement a common instructional framework that aims to increase student engagement utilizing clear shared outcomes and practices.

- Work with the Great Schools Partnership (GSP) to align and be consistent with shared outcomes.
- Build teacher capacity with the Teachers College Staff Developer for instructional focus on reading and writing.
- Implement facilitated Coaches PLC Meetings and Grade Level Data Team meetings.
- Focus on instructional practices that emphasize personalized student goals.
