CONSENT AGENDA ITEM: Consider Approval of the "Statement of Impact" for the

Trinity Basin Preparatory.

ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S): ALL

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

• In accordance with TEA guidelines, proposed charter schools must submit a "Statement of Impact" to any public school district that may be affected by new, proposed campuses or changes to the school's existing charter.

- These statements must be considered by Trustees in an open board meeting and must be returned to TEA by a stated deadline.
- The Trinity Basin Preparatory whose physical address is 400 South Zang Boulevard, Dallas, TX, 75208 has made application of the Texas Education Agency to:
 - Increase the maximum enrollment in their current charter from 3,500 students to 5,000.
 - Add an additional campus at 2524 West Ledbetter Drive, Dallas, TX 75233.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

 The options available on the Texas Education Agency supplied form list only the District's response as to whether or not the District believes the addition of these schools and increase in maximum enrollment will or will not have any major impact on Aledo ISD.

FISCAL NOTE: Consideration of this impact statement has no known impact to the 2016-2017 budget.

Administrative Recommendation: Administration recommends Trustees oppose the Trinity Basin Preparatory application for this charter expansion as the expansion of this charter school potentially harms Aledo ISD.
