Purpose: Middle School Project Status Update

1. Overall Status:

- On time
- On budget
- Completing all commitments
- Bond Oversight Committee toured the middle school site for the second time, met, and reviewed project status and budget on 7/28/2026. No issues or concerns.

2. Construction:

- Andrea was able to secure all the Temporary Construction Easements and PGE utility easements. This was a significant milestone accomplishment.
- Wood and structural framing is ongoing and proceeding well. Over 65% of framing is complete to date.
- Interior walls are receiving mechanical ductwork, plumbing piping, electrical routing infrastructure (rough-in).
- The interior commons area is still fully exposed. The concrete slab in the commons is scheduled to be poured in late November after the commons roofing is complete.
- The north parking lot (off Lynn Lane) has exterior curbs and first layer of asphalt.
- West parking lot and front entrance (along Leroy Ave) is laid out and curb installations are in progress. First layer of asphalt is scheduled between late August to early fall.
- Installation of utilities (fire line and storm lines) are in progress
- Lynn Lane Right of Way work is in progress.
- Leroy Ave work is going well, 60% of sidewalks have been poured, and work in front of the school will be completed before school starts for buses and parents.
- Significant, successful effort have been made to communicate and support neighbors through the disruptions and challenges.

Teaching & Learning School Board Report *for* August 13, 2026

Summer Programs

A four week Elementary Summer School Enrichment Program ran from July 6th thru July 31st: Clarkes and Mulino students did NOT attend Mulino for the summer program. Due to unforeseen construction at Mulino Elementary during July, the Mulino summer program was relocated to Molalla Elementary to ensure student safety. MES and Rural Dell students attended MES for the summer program. In addition there was a four week Middle School Summer Program held at MES due to the construction at the middle school.

The summer program served approximately 284 K-8 students, supported by a dedicated team of 31 staff members. The curriculum delivered a robust core academic foundation in literacy and mathematics, seamlessly blended with project-based learning and enrichment activities. Ultimately, the program cultivated an engaging, collaborative environment where students experienced a deep sense of belonging while having fun. The high school also ran a credit recovery program during the month of July.

Kindergarten Camp

Kindergarten Camps will again happen at all of our elementaries in August. Starting dates for each building program varies but all will have a 30 hour program. The purpose of the camp is to give Kinders a head start on routines, familiarity with the building and staff and most importantly getting them excited for the first day of Kindergarten. Kindergarten Camp is funded by our State Summer Learning Grant.
