	3.	The principal or a designee ordinarily shall be present the questioning or interview. If the interviewer raises principal considers to be a valid objection to a third paper presence, the interview shall be conducted without the son's presence.	what the arty's
STUDENTS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY	Before a student at school is arrested or taken into custody by a law enforcement officer or other legally authorized person, the principal shall verify the official's identity. To the best of his or her ability, the principal shall verify the official's authority to take custody of the student [see GRA] and then shall deliver over the student.		
	The principal shall immediately notify the Superintendent and the parents or other person having lawful control of the student. If the officer or other authorized person raises what the principal considers to be a valid objection to notifying the parents at that time, the principal shall not notify the parents.
