In order to expedite the permitting process and protect the school district's interest in a school site, Hays County recommends adding language to their current agreement, essentially creating a tri-party agreement which defines the Future Elementary School location and size, and identifies the district's infrastructure cost as \$1,200,000 based on the engineer's opinion of probable cost. Staff recommends executing the Tri-party Development Agreement now and working continuously with Lennar to execute a separate donation agreement for the school site.</li> </ul>
