

TSSA Plan 2022-2023

The Mission of Basin Online is to provide Uintah Basin Students with a high quality and effective way of learning online which will prepare the student for advancement into college, career, or preparation for life experiences.

- 1. Our first goal is to improve on our average district math benchmarks scores from Spring 2022 to Spring 2023. As a result of COVID-19 we have seen students returning to school with large gaps in their understanding of math concepts. We would like to use TSSA money to provide professional development for teachers to ensure all of our teachers understand mastery grading. We would like to send three staff members to a Solution Tree training entitled Grading from the Inside Out. These three staff members will then provide Professional Development for the rest of the staff over the 2022-2023 school year.
- 2. Our second goal is that at least 70% of students will be actively participating in coursework as shown on the student completion rate by the end May 2023. In addition to student incentives we are focusing on teacher clarity in our canvas courses. Teachers are creating student friendly objectives with success criteria to allow students to understand what they are learning, why they are learning it and how they will know they are successful. Student progress will be tracked weekly and interventions provided by course teachers to ensure student understanding and progress.

Our plan to reach these goals of our students include the following strategies:

- 1. Our teachers will receive monthly training on Digital Learning and mastery grading. Teachers will attend the training every other Wednesday. Teachers will track students' progress post test and then again after receiving intervention and taking a retake on the post test. Interventions will align with the needs of the students.
- 2. Ensure effective instruction by following the district's guides for pacing and proficiency. Basin Online will purchase the necessary software, programs, technology to track student progress and completion rate. We will be using TSSA money to purchase the Microsoft Suites so that all of our data and
