- ★ **Parade after graduation:** Yes, immediately following the ceremony all graduates will parade through town.

BHS/BHA have the **opportunity** to graduate 143 students this year provided all seniors *pass their courses, finish their community service and portfolio presentations (April 24).*

- ❖ Graduates will have somewhat of a traditional ceremony in the gym with a shortened ceremony, with guests for graduates. Families would sit in pods. This will have the gym at 25%, 50%, or 75% capacity. We can also have a large screen in the parking lot for other audiences.

❖ **Option Outside BHS Sports Field**

- ❖ Graduates would have a somewhat of a traditional ceremony on the field with a shortened ceremony with guests for graduates. Families would sit in pods. This will have the sports complex at 25%, 50%, or 75% capacity. We can also have a large screen in the parking lot for other audiences.
