CAMPUSES:

Capitol Elementary will provide Extended Year and STAAR Preparation/Remediation Program for grades K-4 and the Bilingual program for grades PK-K. The Extended Year and STAAR Preparation/Remediation Program for grades 5-8 will be held at Levelland Middle School. The Migrant Program for grades PK-12 will also be held at Levelland Middle School. The STAAR Preparation/Remediation Program and Credit Recovery for grades 9-12 will be held at Levelland High School. EOC testing during the week of June 24th will be held at Levelland High School.

TIME SCHEDULES:

All classes will start at 8 am. Breakfast will be served from 7:30 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Capitol Elementary and Levelland Middle School. Lunch will also be served from 12:00 noon until 12:30 p.m. Buses will run at that time. Bilingual classes and Migrant classes will meet 8:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. each day. Another bus will run for these students at 3:30 p.m.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation will be provided for eligible students in grades PK-12. Buses will stop at selected sites within the city. Buses will run in the morning, at noon and at 3:30 p.m.

STAFFING:

Teachers and teacher assistants working in the Summer School Program will be compensated based on hours of instruction. Summer School Principals will be responsible for hiring their staff members. Staff members who have previously worked in Summer School and are certified and work in corresponding grades will be considered first. No Summer School employee will be allowed to miss more than one day because of staff development unless permission is granted by the Summer School Principal. Total staff will be determined based on student numbers.

REQUIRED PARTICIPATION:

Students who score ***Did Not Meet*** on the STAAR assessment or who do not meet **state-mandated attendance requirements** are **required** to participate in the summer school program. High school students are required to attend summer school for STAAR remediation and/or credit recovery, as applicable.

Failure to attend the required summer school program may result in campus-determined consequences, including assignment to Accelerated Instruction courses and/or a Grade Placement Committee (GPC) review to determine the student's academic placement for the following school year. Each campus is responsible for maintaining an up-to-date list of required students and documenting the criteria used to determine participation.

SUBSTITUTES:

All personnel who are absent will be responsible for hiring (but not paying) their substitutes. Substitutes should enter work times electronically and will be paid according to True Time records.

TRANSFER STUDENTS:

Students currently not enrolled in Levelland ISD must present a letter from their sending school to the principal of the school they wish to attend indicating that they must attend summer school in order to be promoted to the next grade. A fee of \$100 will be assessed these students. Acceptance into the program is not guaranteed.
