RECOMMENDATION:			
Staff has finalized renewal negotiations with Texas Mutual Insurance (TMIC) and recommends the Board accept the negotiated proposal.			
RATIONALE:			
Last year the Board awarded the district Workers' Compensation Insurance contract to Texas Mutual Insurance (TMIC). This proposal was for $5-1$ (one) year contracts with the first year at a fixed rate and subsequent years to be negotiated and dependent on loss run experience.			
The proposed rate last year was -20.22 % below the 2010-2011 rates. Based on actual and projected losses as well as reduced payroll TMIC is proposing an additional -3.00% <u>reduction</u> in premiums for the 2011-12 school year. See attached worksheet.
