~~The Board has as its primary mission the education of district students according to adopted goals and objectives. To this end all legal and worthwhile financial resources, especially those that will alleviate the local tax burden, will be pursued.~~

~~Grants-in-aid are sometimes available from either~~ The district shall pursue federal, state or private grants or other such funds that will assist the ~~sources. The district in meeting adopted Board and will pursue only those grants that will help the district goals meet adopted goals and objectives of the curriculum or create facilities or purchase equipment that will help meet district goals and objectives.~~

~~Proposals for external funds will be submitted to the Board for evaluation and approval.~~

In the event an opportunity arises to submit a grant proposal and there is insufficient time to place it before the Board, the superintendent is authorized to use their judgment in approving it for submission. The superintendent will review the proposal with the Board at its next regular meeting. The Board reserves the right to reject funds associated with any grant which has been approved.

The Board shall, before an acceptance of such funds, consider the district's ~~The Board is wary of those grants which cause a program to begin, but later leave the cost to be assumed by the district. Every presentation to the Board regarding pursuit of outside funding must include what~~ obligations, expectations or encumbrances ~~will exist~~ when the grant ceases.

~~The Board will tend to look with favor upon such requests for grants that meet the criteria above, have the recommendations of the superintendent, and are explained fully before the grant is requested. The Board reaffirms its veto power over all grants before actual acceptance.~~
