~~The Board encourages students and staff to volunteer for community fundraisers which raise funds that benefit the district and district students.~~ The Board recognizes that declining district resources may not permit the funding of certain programs or school activities at current levels. Programs or activities may be reduced, suspended or discontinued entirely due to budgetary reductions, reallocation of funds or other reasons. The Board also understands the important role ~~that these programs~~ and positive impact a comprehensive cocurricular and extracurricular program activities can have on the individual development of its students, the total school climate and the community at large.

~~The~~ ~~Therefore, the~~ Board may grant permission to school-related or community individuals, groups or organizations and others to provide financial support and/or conduct fund raising on behalf of ~~fundraising for~~ the district to operate designated programs and activities that have been reduced, suspended or discontinued by the district. Maintaining equal educational opportunities for all district students to meet the requirements of Title IX will guide the district in all decisions to reinstate reduced, suspended or discontinued ~~support and maintain~~ programs and activities.

The superintendent is directed to develop an administrative regulation to implement this policy, including a process for individuals, groups and organizations interested in submitting proposals to fund district programs or activities that have been reduced, suspended or discontinued. Following the superintendent's review and recommendation, proposals will be submitted to the Board for final approval.
