1. **Club Goals for the Year:** The Napi Mini Bank goals for the year are to increase the number of students with savings accounts by 50 students. In addition to the 50 savings accounts, the secondary goal is for 100 deposits to be made in the new accounts or an average of two deposits per new account (in addition to the initial deposit that opens the account). The long term goals of the Blackfeet Mini Bank Association are to encourage students to develop savings habits.
