Positive Gram - Still in the middle of the project, but feedback received so far:

- Inconsistency in expectations vs delivery
- Need clarity around what visitors will be doing in the class
- Next year need to offer specific times and days of availability, WAY too burdensome for staff to schedule the way we did this year.
- Perhaps do this work in February rather than so close to the summit
- Fun that each committee member is putting their own spin on the activity, a bit more structure may be needed, but not scripted

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• Tykocki met with Interim Police Chief Jen Brown and learned ELPD is hiring a new social worker with a July start date to cover weekend and evening needs in the community. Desire expressed on ELPD side to "repair" relations with ELPS and find opportunities to recruit from ELHS graduate pool.
