Attendance

Mrs. Flynn's and Mrs. Armstrong's classrooms had "tied" for the highest attendance for the month of September. Students were able to enjoy a treat for being here! Due to the overall high attendance for the month of September, we celebrated with an all school recess, because we were at 95% attendance overall! It is fabulous to see the growth in our attendance!

We are starting to look at the overall percentages of students who are 90% in attendance or greater. So if a classroom of 20 has three students who are less than 90%, that classroom would only be 85% attendance rate. If your child has missed **three or more days this year,** they are already under the 90% mark! We are really striving for classrooms to also be at the 90% of attenders for 90% of the time.
