Resolution

Serious Safety Hazards

WHEREAS, the Illinois School Code, 105 ILCS 5/29-3 provides that students may be transported less than 1 ¹/₂ miles with an approved Serious Safety Hazard; and

WHEREAS, school districts must certify annually via a school board resolution that a serious safety hazard(s) continues to exist;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Streator Elementary School District #44, LaSalle County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. This Board of Education reviewed and determined that the hazardous conditions remain unchanged for the following:

45-80-1 Golf Rd and N. Bloomington St from Frech St to Oakley Ave.

44-05-1 Spring Lake Rd and 18

Section 2. This Board of Education reviewed and determined the following previously declared Hazard Zones as no longer meeting the criteria for serious safety hazards.

45-80-2 Oakland Park- James St- Oakland Park is no longer used as a District Elementary School.

44-05-1 Park Dr., Gaines Dr., Valley Dr. Golf Rd., Golfview Rd., Irene St., and Eastwood Ave. – Eastwood Ave. has a sidewalk the entire length of the Street as of 2017-2018 school year.

Section 3. This Board of Education reviewed and determined an additional area may pose a serious safety hazard to students who are walking to and from Centennial School. The Board of Education will consult with IDOT to determine if a serious safety hazard exists for these areas.

44-18-1 Along North Bloomington from W 2nd St to Oakley Ave, Crossing N Bloomington from Marilla Park Rd, including Erven Ave. and Acres Dr.
