Several of our self-contained classes have went on field trips recently. When the students are out in the community they are able to work on multiple skills such as communication, behavior, and money. This is allowing us to measure how well the students are learning in the “real world” setting.

We have had several meetings with our out-of-district students. The students are doing well with some adjustments needing to be made to allow for the possibility for success.

This year, Dupo has several students who attend the Collinsville Vocational program (CAVC). Staff at CAVC do a good job of working with our students with IEP's. Although, they do not have special education teachers, we are always here to provide assistance to their staff if any of our students are struggling. Also, when students return to Dupo at the end of the day, they have access to special education teachers to assist them in any areas they may need some additional help.
