### **Enrollment & Attendance**

Charles R. Leask Sr. Middle School currently serves 59 students. Average daily attendance for October was 90%. We continue to reinforce the importance of consistent school attendance through family communication and positive recognition for students with strong attendance habits.

Teachers are currently completing the i-Ready assessments for both reading and mathematics. These assessments will provide valuable mid-fall data to guide instructional planning and targeted supports.
