- No Cost to Duncanville ISD
- Assign a campus liaison to coordinate with HCC for services.
- Assign a counseling department liaison to oversee standards and service delivery.
- Provide referrals to agency programs or other appropriate services.
- Offer confidential spaces for consultations, assessments, and counseling sessions.
- Collaborate on parent, faculty, and staff presentations about referrals, services, and student support topics.
