Dear Parents,

As part of the 2005 school bond package, LISD is opening its very first 9/10 center and converting the present Killough 9th grade center to a 9/10 center as well. With the opening of the new school and the conversion of Killough, it is necessary to start the adoption process of the schools' attendance boundaries.

Research has shown that smaller learning communities enhance the educational opportunities for the students. It is for this reason that Lewisville ISD will open two 9/10 centers for the 2011/2012 school year.

As has become standard practice in LISD, the Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing on January 27, 2011 at 6:30 PM at Lewisville High School. The public hearing is not required by law, but LISD officials want to ensure that all community concerns are addressed before the boundaries are adopted.
