Subject: Renewal of RFP #F1060-23 Student Athletic/UIL Accident Insurance

Background Information:

- The Board of Trustees previously awarded RFP #F1060-23 Student Athletic/UIL Accident Insurance on June 12, 2023. If approved, this renewal would be the third year of a five-year term.
- If renewed, this University Interscholastic League (UIL) accident insurance policy would
 continue to provide coverage for students involved in UIL athletics/activities including
 cheerleading (cheerleading summer camps included), band, drill team, vocational classes,
 ROTC, FFA and 4-H. The recommended policy would also continue to provide coverage for
 all participants in UIL-sponsored events. In addition, all students (PK-12) on day field trips
 would continue to be included in the policy.
- The proposed current insurance policy would continue to provide secondary coverage for medical expenses, rehabilitation, and durable equipment. If parents or guardians do not have primary medical coverage, this policy would then act as a primary policy.
- The awarded vendor(s) allows for the appointed LISD administrative staff to meet and have direct contact with the insurance provider pertaining to claims, forms, and benefits in the event a claim is issued.
- For policy year 2023-2024, claims analysis indicated 152 claims were filed and the total for policy claims paid was \$117,496.
- For policy year 2024-2025, claims analysis indicated 101 claims were filed and the current total for policy claims paid, incurred, and pending year to date is \$76,942.

Administrative Consideration:

- The proposed policy offers the same coverage that LISD's current policy contains with no policy premium increase due to LISD's historically consistent low number of claims.
- Funds for these services will come from the LISD Benefits Department budget.
- Previous annual expenditures:
 - o 2024-2025: \$182,758
- Estimated annual expenditures: \$182,758 but will not exceed the approved budget.
- This procurement complies with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code.

Recommendations:

 That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the renewal of RFP #F1060-23 Student Athletic/UIL Accident Insurance, the recommended vendor(s), and the estimated annual expenditures for one year.
