**2. Student Performance** - The ineligibility list (students with F's) is down 53 percent from last year (2020) and it is down 9 percent from 2019. Amazing job students and teachers. On the other side of this the amount of discipline has been up from the past years; especially due to tardiness. We have been and will be working on some plans to remediate this. Most behavior issues have been fairly minor as students are beginning to settle in. Another positive note is that we had 18 students take the PSAT test (most that I can find in any given year - 25 total for 3 years combined). We had 6 - 10th graders and 12 - 11th graders. We have one student that finished in the upper 95th percentile, which is extremely good and we will await National Merit status. Our average from 18 students is on par with the past two years, showing that our students may not be as far behind as was predicted. Great job students, teachers and Ms. Routh.
