H.B. No. 6206: An act concerning later middle and high school start times.

That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit regularly scheduled instruction classes before **8:30 a.m.** in any public **middle or high school**.

 H.B. No. 6222: An act concerning the establishment of later middle and high school start times.

That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit, for the school year commencing July 1, 2021, and each school year thereafter, regularly scheduled instruction classes before 8:00 a.m. in any public middle or high school, and to permit a local or regional board of education to establish a start time that is appropriate for the needs of the school district and its students, including a trial period to pilot alternate start times.

H.B. No. 6626: An act concerning later high school start times.

That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit regularly scheduled instruction classes before **8:30 a.m.** in any public **high school**.

 H.B. No. 5976: An act establishing a task force to conduct a study concerning school start times.

That the general statutes be amended to establish a task force to conduct a study concerning the starting time for regularly scheduled instruction in public schools.

- H.B. No. 6613: An act permitting Boards of education to revise school Bus routes to reflect actual student ridership.
 - That section 10-186 of the general statutes be amended to authorize a local or regional board of education to revise school bus routes to reflect actual student ridership, provided such board holds seats in order to accommodate any changes in student needs that may arise during the school year.
