5	The Madison Board of Education (the "Board") recognizes its legal responsibility to ensure		
6	that all provide school accommodations to children five years of compulsory school age		
7	have the opportunity to receive an education age and over and under twenty-one years of		
8	age who are not graduates of a high school or technical education and career school. The		
9	Board further recognizes the state law requiring parents/guardians to cause children ages		
10	five to eighteen to attend a public school regularly, unless such child is a high school		
11	graduate or the parent/guardian is able to show that the child is adequate and elsewhere		
12	receiving equivalent to that which they are entitled under the lawinstruction in the studies		
13	taught in the public schools.		
14			
15	Parents wishing to educate children in the home may do so in compliance with Connecticut		
16	General Statutes and regulations of the Connecticut State Board of EducationAgencies. The		
17	parent or guardian shall provide the Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum, Instruction		
18	and Assessment with the following:		
19			
20	(a) a "Letter of Intent to Home School" to be placed on file; and		
21			
22	(b) an outline of the annual portfolio to be used to determine if the student		
23	received completed by the parent/guardian or provider of homeschool instruction		
24	that details the instruction being provided, which is required to be equivalent		
25	instruction in the required coursesstudies taught in the public schools.		
26			
27	When parents / guardians choose to educate their children at home, the school district shall		
28	provide whatever reasonable assistance it can to ensure such children benefit appropriately		
29	from home instruction.		
30			
31	If decisions are made by parents / guardians to return children to local schools who for a		
32	time have been educated at home, school staff shall provide an appropriate return to the		
33	public schools per Policy #5070.2		
34 25	The Board authorized the Superintendent of Schools or designed to deviate administrative		
35	The Board authorizes the Superintendent of Schools or designee to develop administrative		

36 <u>regulations to implement this policy, if necessary</u>.
