Dear Dr. Hardwick:

An offer has been made for the purchase of a tax sale property owned in trust by the Bee County taxing authorities as a result of the property's failure to sell at tax sale on the courthouse steps for the entire amount of delinquent taxes and costs owed. Bee County has formally approved and submitted a one hundred dollar bid offer for this U-shaped road in the Salazar Heights subdivision so that it may improve and maintain these roads for its citizens. The road was offered for purchase at tax sale twice—once on September 5, 2006 and the second time on March 6, 2007. The property is not desirable to potential tax sale purchasers due to the fact that it is essentially a deeded easement that property owners use to come and go from their properties. The improvement and maintenance of this road will provide a better standard of living for Bee County citizens and may well entice potential purchasers into buying any of the other twelve lots currently owing outstanding back taxes.

Please place this as a consent agenda item on the agenda of the School Board meeting to be held October 16, 2007. A suggested wording of this item is as follows:

"Consideration and approval of bid from Bee County for improvement and maintenance of the roads in the Salazar Heights Subdivision."
